April 10, 2007

1. CALL TO ORDER: 7:37pm.

2. **PRESIDENT (Joanne Fahrforth)**: Joanne welcomed everyone to the meeting.

3. **SECRETARY (Debbie Willems)**: Read thank you notes from Bryce Cann, Nancy Guzzardi, Monroe Middle School. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Chris Smith and seconded by Nancy Link.

4. **TREASURER (Karen Cervenka)**: Karen explained the difference in monies for the Dinner Dance from last month's report. Expenses were still coming in as well as incomes. Our monthly ending balance is \$185,439.85. Both March and April's reports will be filed for audit.

5. **PRINCIPAL (Jill Bullo)**: Jill was absent, Matt reported for her. Prairie State and PLAN tests are coming up at the end of the month. Prairie State is now a requirement for graduation. An incentive to do well is going to be implemented. If a student meets or exceeds on his/her test, they can opt out of an exam next year. Graduation is scheduled for Saturday, May 26th at 3:00pm at College of DuPage.

6. **ATHLETIC DIRECTOR (Matt Fisher)**: Spring seasons are under way. There have been weather issues causing teams to cancel events. The office does try to reschedule whenever possible. Wheaton Park District and District 200 partnered to equip the fitness center with state of the art exercise equipment. Because it is a partnership, park members can use the facilities during designated times.
